





- 2. Motivation letter
- 3. Essay
- 4. Bachelor's degree + transcript
- 5. Proof of English proficiency
- 6. Declaration of Authorship
- 7. APS certificate (applicants from India, China, Vietnam, Mongolia only)
- Any further certificates relevant to the programme (optional)



September Application platform open from October September 15th until November 30th November Early December: selection committee meets, formal admission checked by Admissions Office December Applicants receive notice on acceptance, rejection, or placement on waiting list until December 24th January Applicants confirm place offer until January 6th February Applicants move up from waiting list until end of March March Matriculation period Start of programme towards April the middle of April
