The application process

September **Required documents:** Application platform open from CV October September 15th until November 30th **Motivation letter** November Early December: selection committee meets, formal Research proposal admission checked by Admissions Office December Applicants receive notice on acceptance, rejection, or Bachelor degree + placement on waiting list until December 24th January transcript Applicants confirm place offer until January 6th February Proof of English proficiency Applicants move up from waiting list until end of March 2 letters of recommendation March Matriculation period (template!) Start of programme towards April the middle of April

The time line

Semesters / Place	Time	Estimated tuition fees
1. Freiburg	April 2023 – July 2023	1,500€ (non-EU students)
2. Buenos Aires or Cape Town	July/August 2023 – December 2023	FLACSO: 950€ UCT: 1,500-1,750€
3. New Delhi or Bangkok	January 2024 – May 2024	Delhi: 1.200\$ Bangkok: 800-1000€
Internship	June – October 2024	
4. Freiburg	November 2024 – March 2025	1,500€ (non-EU students)
5. Potential 5 th semester	April 2025 – August 2025 (depending on registration for thesis). Note that students need to be matriculated in Freiburg for two final examination semesters.	1,500€ (non-EU students)






The modules

Example: Lecture "Global and Regional Transformations" by Prof. Manuela Boatca (1st term)
