




The application process

Required documents:

- CV
- Motivation letter
- Research proposal
- Bachelor degree + transcript
- Proof of English proficiency
- 2 letters of recommendation (template!)

The time line

Semesters / Place	Time	Estimated tuition fees
1. Freiburg	April 2025 – July 2025	1,500€ (non-EU students)
2. Buenos Aires or Cape Town	July/August 2025 – December 2025	FLACSO: 1,400€ UCT: 1,500-5.000€
3. New Delhi or Bangkok	January 2026 – May 2026	Delhi: 1,200\$ Bangkok: 1000€
Internship	June 2026 – October 2026	
4. Freiburg	November 2026 – March 2027	1,500€ (non-EU students)
5. Potential 5 th semester	April 2027 – August 2027 (depending on registration for thesis). Note that students need to be matriculated in Freiburg for two final examination semesters.	1,500€ (non-EU students)






The modules


