Extract: Study Programme MA in Social Sciences (Global Studies Programme); approved at the Albert-Ludwigs-University Freiburg i.Br., 08.02.2002, p. 5:

Internships are compulsory. They comprise practical work in public or private institutions through which students will gain insight into the organization and operation of a career in a societal field which they might seek at a later stage.

Internships shall cover a **minimum period of 6 weeks** and shall be undertaken during the break of approx. five months *between the third and fourth semester*. Students will gain **4 ECTS credits** (European Credit Transfer System) for the successful completion of their internship. This means the internship must comprise at least 110 working hours.

On completion of the internship, a **report** must be submitted which reflects the social scientific dimensions of the field of work during the internship. Employers must confirm that the internship was completed.
