The Tuition Fees are per semester, the living costs are per month. Flight and living costs are based on estimates and may vary. The tuition fees are estimates only and are subject to change.

There is, however, the option to get the fees for the fifth semester reimbursed in case the final examination process is completed early. This does not have an impact on study duration: the
		programme can still be completed in four semesters.
